Introduction

This section contains information on all aspects of the FRS analysed by Local Government District (LGD), also commonly referred to as District Council.

NI has 26 District Councils, and due to a small sample of cases in NI, the following analysis has been carried out by combining the 2002-03 and 2003-04 samples.

Contents and points to note when interpreting tables

2002-03 and 2003-04 survey cases have been combined, resulting in a total of 16 District Councils being represented independently. Due to sample size requirements, Cookstown & Magherafelt, Larne & Moyle and Omagh & Strabane have been combined. An 'Other' category has also been created, which combines Antrim, Ballymoney, Carrickfergus and Limavady.

Councils which have been combined have been selected purely to satisfy sample size requirements, and not on a geographical basis. It is hoped that in the 2004-05 publication, we will be in a position to provide analysis of at least a further six councils independently. It is unlikely that areas such as Moyle and Magherafelt will ever reach a sufficient sample size within any three year period.

Section 8 Summary

- Fermanagh, Banbridge and Newry & Mourne District Councils have the highest average household size of 2.9, compared to 2.6 in NI.
- Belfast District Council has the highest proportion of households where the age of head is over 75 (14%). Belfast, along with Cookstown & Magherafelt also have the highest proportion of head of households under 25.
- Omagh & Strabane and Castlereagh have the highest percentage of households with one or more adults over pension age (36%), compared to Derry which has the lowest (17%).
- Newry & Mourne has the highest percentage of households with children (47%), with the next highest being Craigavon (44%). The NI average is 36%.
- The District Council with the highest proportion of lone parent benefit units is Belfast (12%), followed by Craigavon and Derry (9%). The NI average is 7%.
- Newry & Mourne and Banbridge have the highest proportion of self employed benefit units at 15%.
- Ballymena has the highest proportion of benefit units where at least one adult is in full time work (56%).
- Households in Omagh & Strabane receive the highest percentage of income from social security benefits (14%), compared to the NI average of 8%.
- Omagh & Strabane also have the highest percentage of households in receipt of at least one benefit (90%). The District Council with the lowest percentage is Ards at 64%. The NI average is 77%.
- North Down have the highest percentage of households which have taken out Private Medical Insurance (17%), compared to 10% over NI as a whole.
- Dungannon has the highest proportion of private rented households (17%), compared to Castlereagh with the lowest (3%).
- Belfast has the highest proportion of social rented households (30%), compared to the NI average of 18%.
- 24% of households in Belfast and Fermanagh have no accounts or investments, compared to 15% in NI.
