Introduction

This section contains information on all aspects of the FRS analysed by Local Government District (LGD), also commonly referred to as District Council.

NI has 26 District Councils, and due to a small sample of cases in NI, the following analysis has been carried out by combining the 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 samples.

Contents and points to note when interpreting tables

2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 survey cases have been combined, resulting in a total of 20 District Councils being represented independently. Due to sample size requirements, Cookstown & Magherafelt, Larne & Moyle and Omagh & Strabane have been combined.

Councils which have been combined have been selected purely to satisfy sample size requirements, and not on a geographical basis. It is unlikely that areas such as Moyle and Magherafelt will ever reach a sufficient sample size within any three year period.

Changes to tables between 2003-04 and 2004-05

The 2003-04 publication also included a category named 'Other', which combined Antrim, Ballymoney, Carrickfergus and Limavady.

The combination of three year's data has meant that these councils can be presented independently, hence the 'Other' category has been removed.

Section 8 Summary

- Newry & Mourne District Council has the highest average household size of 3.0, closely followed by Ballymoney at 2.9. The NI average is to 2.6.
- Belfast and Lisburn District Councils have the highest proportion of households where the age of head is under 25 (7%). Larne & Moyle has the highest proportion of head of households 75 and over (14%).
- Larne & Moyle has the highest percentage of households with one or more adults over pension age (39%), compared to Derry which has the lowest (19%).
- Newry & Mourne has the highest percentage of households with children (47%), with the next highest being Antrim (45%). The NI average is 36%.
- The District Council with the highest proportion of lone parent benefit units is Belfast (10%), followed by Craigavon and Derry (9%). The NI average is 7%.
- Ballymoney and Banbridge have the highest proportion of self employed benefit units at 17%.
- Banbridge has the highest proportion of benefit units where at least one adult is in full time work (55%).
- Households in Derry and Omagh & Strabane receive the highest percentage of income from non-disability social security benefits (13%), compared to the NI average of 7%.
- Omagh & Strabane also have the highest percentage of households in receipt of at least one benefit (90%). The District Council with the lowest percentage is Ards at 66%. The NI average is 77%.
- North Down have the highest percentage of households which have taken out Private Medical Insurance (17%), compared to 10% over NI as a whole.
- Omagh and Strabane has the highest proportion of private rented households (15%), compared to Carrickfergus with the lowest (4%).
- Belfast has the highest proportion of social rented households (29%), compared to the NI average of 18%.
- 20% of households in Belfast, Fermanagh and Cookstown & Magherafelt have no accounts or investments, compared to 12% in NI.
