BELB will shortly be carrying out an Economic Appraisal on options for the redevelopment of Belfast Central Library. Among the various options considered will be the option of splitting the specialist regional (reference) library functions from the branch library function (Belfast Central Lending branch), with the public lending library moving to a site in the City's retail/ office core.

At this stage I would like to flag up the possibility that, depending on the outcome of the EA, we may be looking for a suitable location for Belfast Central Lending in the City Centre shopping/ office core. Jackie Johnston is familiar with the issues involved.
